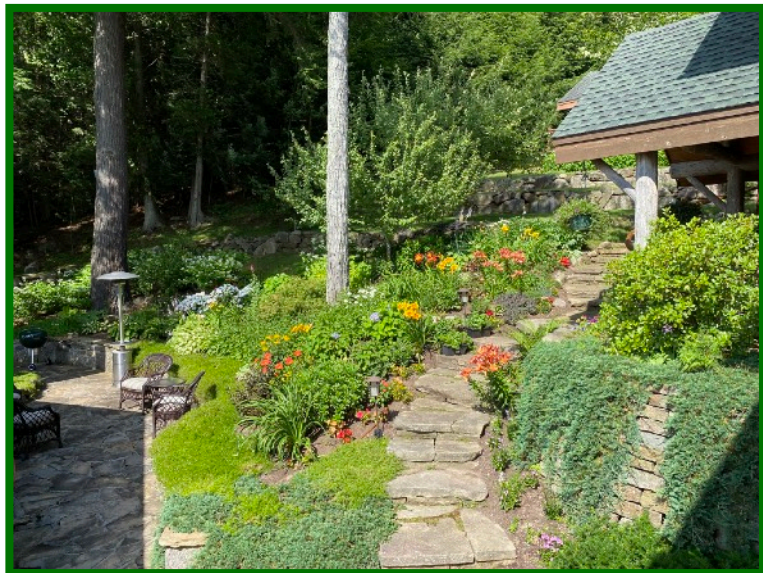

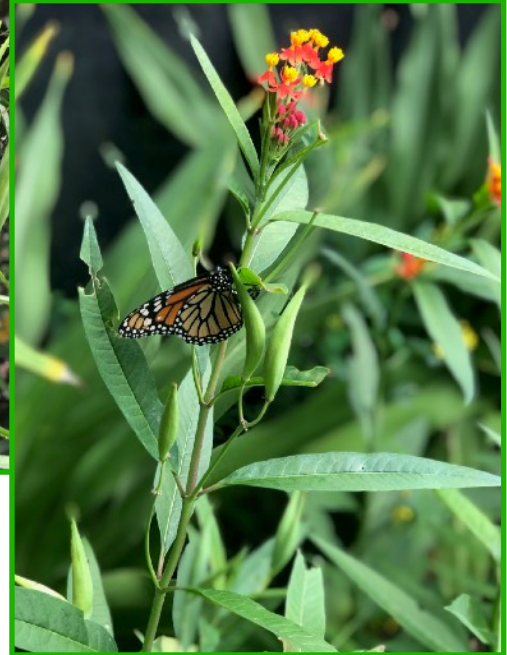
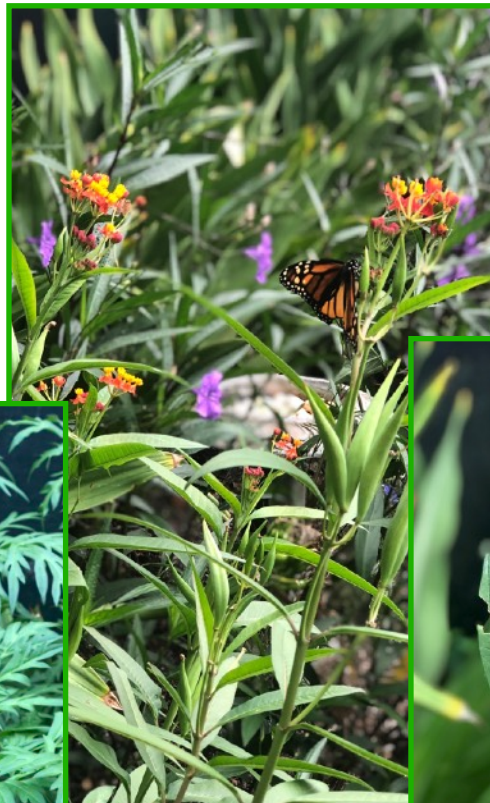

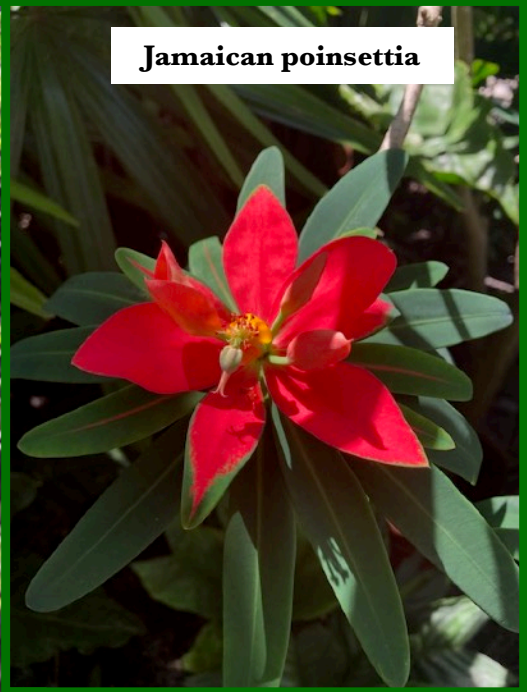

# Anne Pepper's Six-O, Las Vegas, NM

*This year I made these stone groupings using found pieces of stone-slate. I think that the highway department dumped in the ditches along our country road. The heads are found stones all naturally balancing.*

- (1) This group is looking at rock which has a **whale shape** on it- hard to see.
- (2) This one is kind of a **Black Lives Matter** memorial for George Floyd.
- (3) Making art with what you have- **blue bottles** from a lavender and aloe skin tonic I get from Kaffee's Spa in WPB and dried cholla branches.
- (4) This is a shrine in the **pet cemetery**. I bought the wood piece. The statue was done by a sculptor in Santa-Fe, a friend of mothers and I made the flowers from all the beer cans on our country road. Lots of cut fingertips. Very New Mexican.
- (5) Pet cemetery with 2 cairns and a fold arty stone memorial for my beloved **Peanut** who was killed by a rattle snake.
- (6) This is a stone memorial for my **Mother, Father and sister, Clare**, all from found stones. I bought the two window arches from an antique store.
- (7) In my garden, a **lion** guards the west side garden.
- (8) This is the view of **Starvation Peak** to the west towards Santa Fe. (\*left)
- (9) This is the front courtyard- very small- **stonecrop sedum** is the anchoring plant. I have divided this multiple times since it seems to like growing here.
