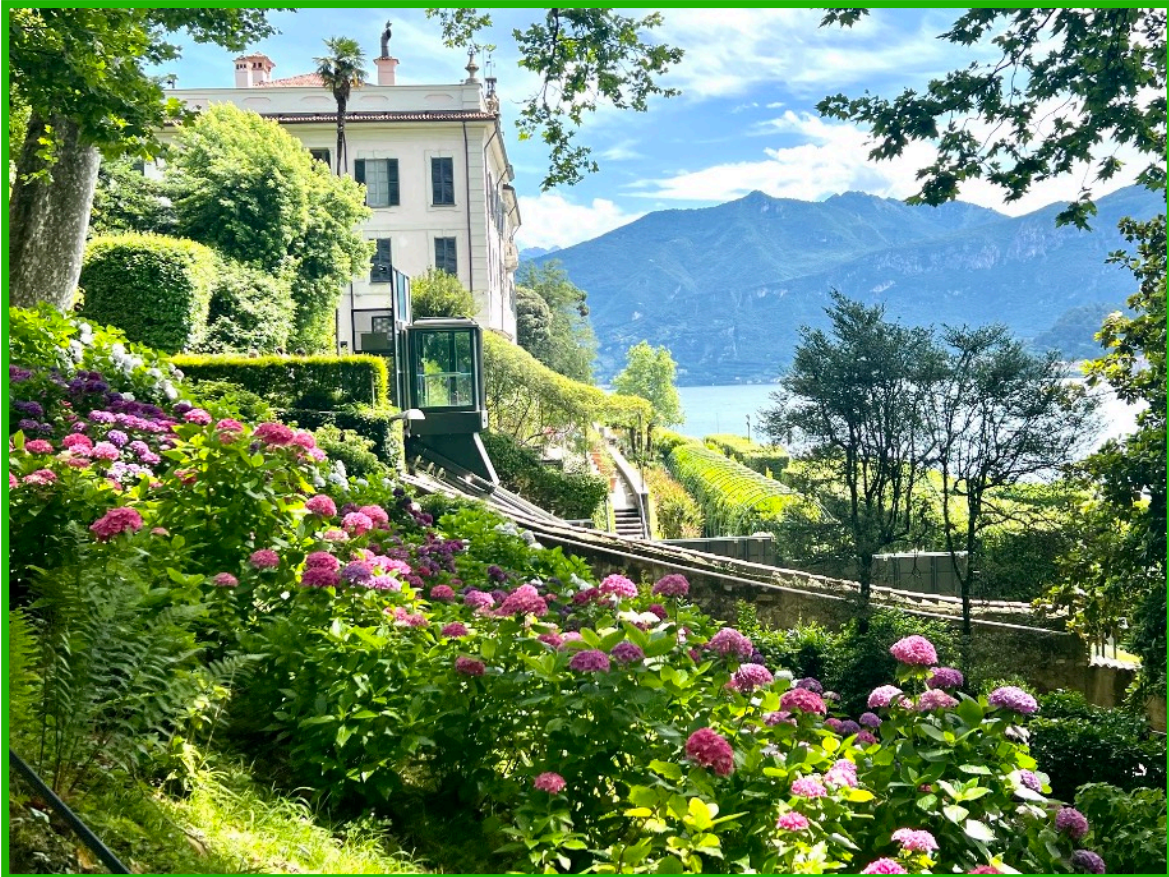
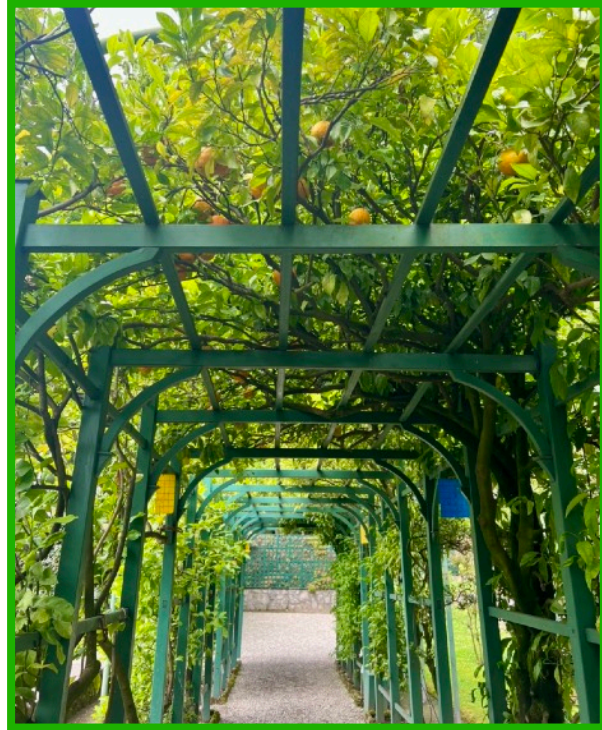

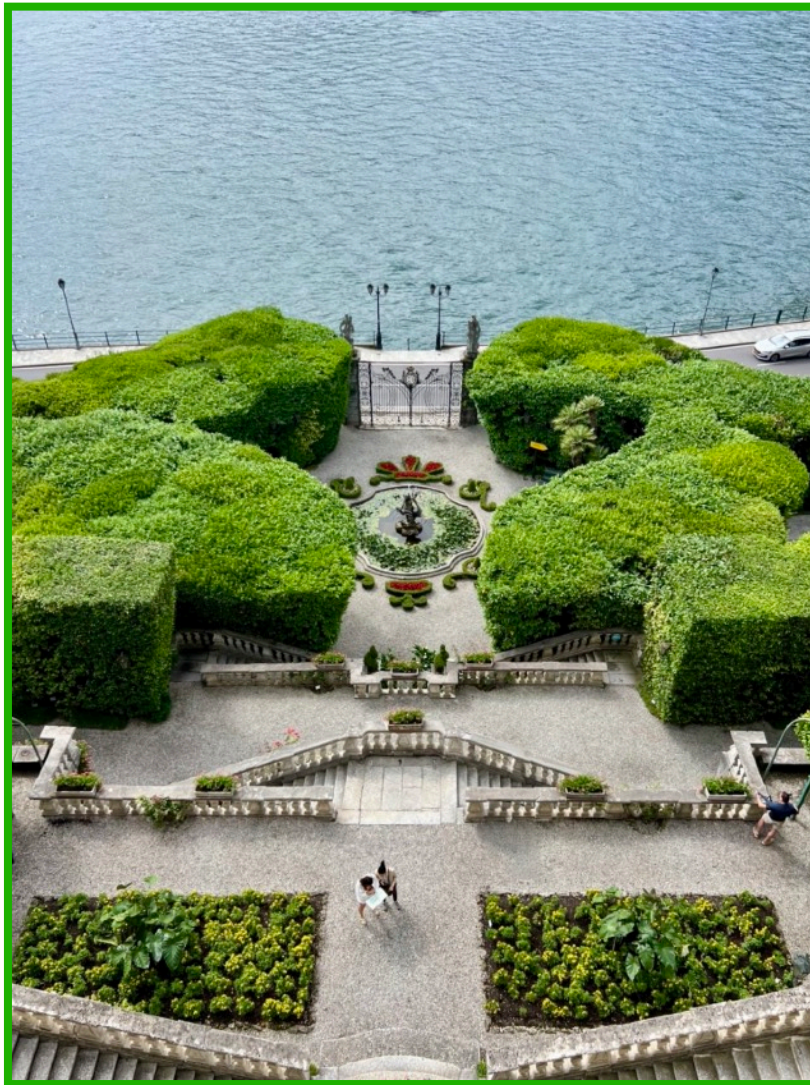
Christina writes: “Here is Villa Carlotta in Tremezzo, a late 17th-century villa famous for its art collection and botanical gardens. The orange trellis arches flanking the entrance were tremendous, as were some of the centuries-old specimen trees: here is a cedar. The large swaths of hydrangeas in many colors we don't see as often in the U.S. were a sight to behold.”





Christina continues: "... The floral at Lake Como was fascinating because of the temperate climate there were plants that we see both in Florida and up North. Hydrangeas next to bromeliads, palms next to cedars. Villa Carlotta has many such examples.."
